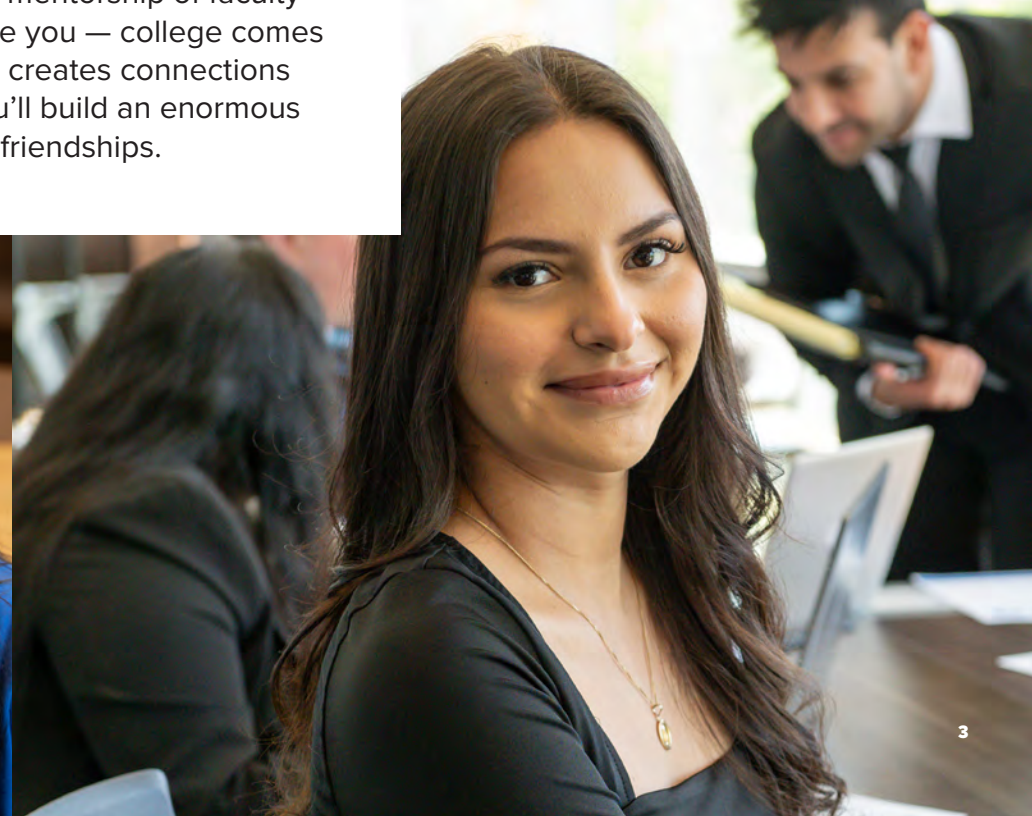
RESEARCH EXCELLENCE

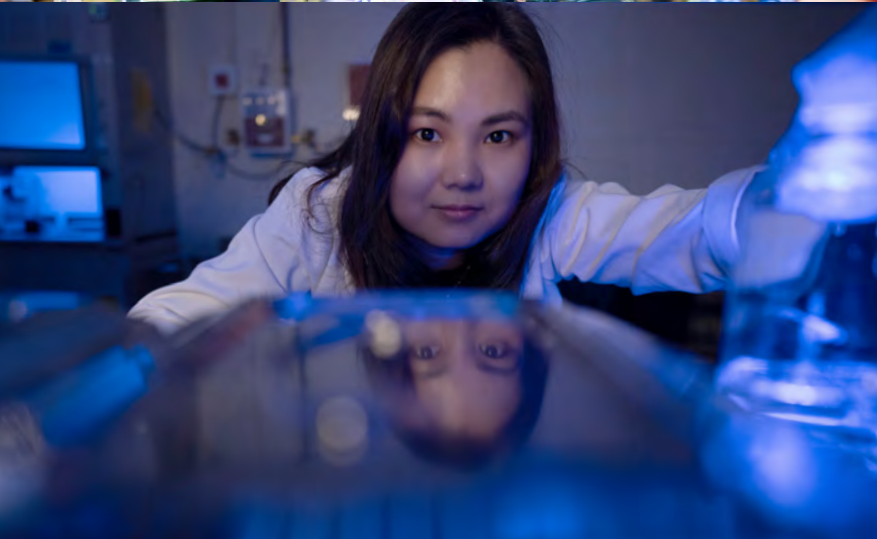

The UofM offers the same tuition rate per credit hour for both traditional and online courses.

FOR TENNESSEE RESIDENTS

Students who are residents of Tennessee will never be charged for credit hours above 12 as an undergraduate or for hours above 10 as graduate students. That means all the hours you take above those thresholds are tuition free.

APPLY NOW

STEP 1

Go to memphis.edu/admissions and click **APPLY NOW**. Complete applications include: \$25 application fee, high school transcript, college transcripts (transfer applicants) and ACT or SAT scores. Admission review is holistic and we super score!

STEP 2

File a FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) in Fall 2024 at studentaid.gov to apply for federal and state financial aid, including the Tennessee HOPE Lottery Scholarship and Memphis Access awards.

STEP 3

We super score at the UofM! If available, send all your ACT/SAT scores and we'll select the best subscores to calculate a super score for admission and scholarship review. Apply for admission before the **December 1** priority date to receive maximum consideration for all available academic scholarships. We encourage students to submit updated test scores and GPA information until **March 1**.
