

File a FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) in Fall 2024 at **studentaid.gov** to apply for federal and state financial aid, including the Tennessee HOPE Lottery Scholarship and Memphis Access awards.

#### STEP 3

We super score at the UofM! If available, send all your ACT/SAT scores and we'll select the best subscores to calculate a super score for admission and scholarship review. Apply for admission before the **December 1** priority date to receive maximum consideration for all available academic scholarships. We encourage students to submit updated test scores and GPA information until **March 1**.
