
# NAVIGATING THE UNDERGRADUATE CATALOG Information for Advisors

### On the left side panel:

<u>Catalog Search</u> – the catalog is searchable\_using keywords for the categories: program, courses, other catalog content or entire catalog.

**About** – gives details about the University of Memphis, including Statement of Mission, General Description, Accreditation, Catalog Applicability, and more.

<u>Undergraduate Catalog Archive</u> – links to all on-line Catalogs back to 1995-1996

<u>Courses</u> – the link to Course Descriptions, searchable by Course Prefix, Course Number, Course Type or Keywords

<u>Majors, Minors, and Certificates</u> – lists of all Undergraduate Majors, Minors, ABM Programs, and Certificate Programs

<u>University Faculty and Staff</u> – listing of colleges and their faculty and staff
