

University of Memphis Dual Enrollment Fall 2026

Registration begins April 15



Students interested in taking a course at The University of Memphis while still enrolled in high school must apply for Dual Enrollment Admission.

Requirements for Dual Enrollment Admission (Online, or Memphis Campus)

- 19 composite score on the ACT
- 100 admissions index score: 30 times the high school GPA (based on a 4.0 scale) plus the composite ACT score.
Example: High School GPA of a 2.85 X 30 = 85.5 + 19 = 104.5 *Some courses may have additional pre-requisites

Application Procedures for Admission- Please allow 3 weeks to complete this process.

- Complete the online dual enrollment application, select “joint enrollment” as student type: https://apply.memphis.edu/portal/ug_app
- Send official test scores, a letter of recommendation and all official transcripts
Students who have previously used the Dual Enrollment Grant at other institutions must have an official copy of their transcript/s sent to dualenrollment@memphis.edu
- **August 1st is the last day to complete the application process.** The application, transcripts, test scores, and letter of recommendation must all be received by the deadline.

After you are admitted:

1. Activate your student account at <https://iam.memphis.edu> using the code provided to you in your acceptance email.
2. Sign and email the Hold Harmless document to dualenrollment@memphis.edu
3. Hepatitis B Immunization Form- electronic only
4. Request a permit for a class via email. Note: Permits **must be issued before you register.**
5. Instructions for registration will be provided once a permit has been issued.
6. Pay course fees. Information regarding fees may be found at www.memphis.edu/dualenrollment/pdfs/de_fee_chart.pdf
7. Apply for the Dual Enrollment Grant, which can cover part of the course fees <https://www.collegefortn.org/tsacstudentportal/>
