

## Canvas Setup for LTI 1.3 – Add Tevera Links to Courses via Modules

### Summary

To add Tevera links via course assignments or modules, the external tool would need to have been created and installed already. If you are unable to find a Tevera LTI 1.3 tool option when creating class assignments, please confirm that the tool has been created and installed at the account, sub-account, or course level. ### Instructions

1. Access your course in Canvas
2. Create a new **Module**
3. Enter a general name for the module, like "Access to Tevera" or "Tevera LTI Link"
4. Click the plus button to add an item to the module
5. In the Add drop-down menu, Choose **External Tool**
6. In the list of LTI tools, select the Tevera LTI 1.3 tool for your program  
**NOTE:** The Tevera LTI tools are program-specific. Please choose the tool that corresponds to the program students from your class will be associated with. If students from multiple programs will have access to the course, please add all appropriate links and guide your students accordingly.
7. Select the **Load in a new tab** checkbox
8. Click **Add Item**

**IMPORTANT:** Only *one* Tevera LTI link is needed in each Canvas course and *should not* be tied to any other assignments! If you have students from more than one program in your course, see the note below **Step 6**.
