Data analysis:

The EPP has 721 candidates whose data was collected in all subjects to evaluate teaching effectiveness. 106(15%) candidates were a level 5- Most Effective;118(16%) was a level 4- Above average effectiveness; 251 (35%) was a level 3- Average effectiveness, 1.6(15%) was alevel 2- approaching effectiveness, and 140(19%) was a level 1- least effectiveness.

Although the EPP found that most candidates (66%) scored 3-average effectiveness or higher, there is still concern for candidates who score 1 and 2 (34%). The EPP plans to provide praxis support earlier in the program to support candidates with preparation.
