Teaching All Learners (BSEd) I Leads to dual licensure as an Elementary (K-5) classroom teacher and a Special Education Interventionist for grades K-8 or 6-12.

Integrated Early Childhood (BSEd) | Leads to Tennessee licensure in Early Childhood Education (PreK-3).

Integrative Studies: Secondary Math (BSEd) | Leads to Secondary Mathematics (6-12) licensure.

Integrative Studies: Youth Development (BSEd) | For students interested in working in non-profits and educational support settings.

### **APPLY NOW**

### STEP 1

Go to <u>memphis.edu/admissions</u> and click **APPLY NOW**. Complete applications include: \$25 application fee, high school transcript, college transcripts (transfer applicants) and ACT or SAT scores. Admission review is holistic and we super score!

### STEP 2

File a FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) in Fall 2024 at **<u>studentaid.gov</u>** to apply for federal and state financial aid, including the Tennessee HOPE Lottery Scholarship and Memphis Access awards.

### STEP 3

We super score at the UofM! If available, send all your ACT/SAT scores and we'll select the best subscores to calculate a super score for admission and scholarship review. Apply for admission before the **Dec. 1** priority date to receive maximum consideration for all available academic scholarships. We encourage students to submit updated test scores and GPA information until **March 1**.
