Highlighting the significance of training and effective communication during cutover and blackout periods to facilitate campus community understanding and transition to the new system.



# >>> HIGHLIGHTS

- Additional Testing | The extended timeline includes two additional System
   Integration Testing (SIT) phases SIT3 and SIT4 to allow for more thorough
   testing of the system and fix defects prior to the launch of Oracle Cloud.
  - System Integration Testing (SIT): The process of executing the real-life scenarios to ensure all systems are properly prepared for integration
  - User Acceptance Testing (UAT): Includes a larger number of testers from the campus community than the previous testing cycles. This is the last round of testing before the system is ready for end users
- More Rigorous Cutover Preparation | Two dress rehearsals are organized for the team to execute prior to the final transition to the new system.
- Training and Communication Timing I The schedule identifies Train the
  Trainer (TTT), sessions for those that will assist in distributing training
  materials, in September and End User Training (EUT), training for all users
  on campus to learn how to conduct role-specific daily processes in Oracle
  Cloud, October through November.
- Early Learning Opportunities I Take advantage of the virtual sessions, online materials and training offered by SOAR to become as prepared as possible for the transition to Oracle Cloud.
- No Activity During Holiday Break (Last two weeks in December)
