TESTING



System Integration Testing (SIT) is the process of executing the real-life scenarios to ensure all systems are properly prepared for integration. The final round of testing, SIT4, began mid-August and is concluding this week.

User Acceptance Testing (UAT) starts next week, including a larger number of testers from the campus community than the previous testing cycles.

SIT4 concluded the four rounds of internal testing before the system is tested by a group of end users. Following UAT, training for the campus community will begin!

TRAINING



Train the Trainer (TTT) sessions have begun, instructing those that will assist in providing training to end-users.

Training for all users on campus to learn how to conduct rolespecific daily processes in Oracle Cloud will be available October. Training information will be updated on the SOAR Website.

IMPORTANT UPDATES

>>> Pay Cards - Moving Away from Paper Checks

Beginning Oct. 1, payroll checks will be distributed via pay cards or direct deposit. Traditional paper checks will no longer be issued.

Employees who do not have direct deposit will automatically be issued a digital pay card for the first payroll (BW21 or MN10), and a physical card will be mailed to them by the bank afterwards. Digital pay cards will be issued through an app (Dash Paycard) downloaded on the employee's phone or personal device.

>>> eContracts Freeze - Nov. 19
