



About IFTI

The Intermodal Freight Transportation Institute (IFTI) at the University of Memphis was established in 2005 to address critical issues affecting the planning, design and operation of the nation's intermodal freight transportation system with an emphasis on the intermodal issues and opportunities that have special significance for Memphis, the State of Tennessee, the lower Mississippi Delta region, and the national and international corridors that cross and intersect in the southeastern U.S.

IFTI's expertise is in risk management, systems analysis and policy development. The Institute engages faculty from the University of Memphis and Vanderbilt University who represent a wide-range of disciplines including civil and transportation engineering, logistics, supply chain management, GIS, environmental studies and earth science.
