



CANVAS QUIZ ENGINE UPDATES

Canvas Quiz Engine Transition Timeline: The transition from the classic quiz engine to the new quiz engine in Canvas, is aiming for full implementation by January 2026. The transition will be gradual, with automatic conversions starting in June 2025 and the creation of new classic quizzes being disabled by August 2025.

Current Usage: Currently, about 58% of quizzes within Canvas are classic quizzes, indicating a significant portion of faculty will be affected by the transition.

Automatic Conversion: Starting in June 2025, any time a faculty member initiates a course copy, classic quizzes will be automatically converted to new quizzes, streamlining the transition process.

Faculty Support for Quiz Transition: Most faculty will experience an automated transition to the new quiz engine, with additional support and training provided for those who use quizzes in more technical or unconventional ways.


