udents and/or faculty may observe you or your family member during therapy or evaluation sessions. This cludes observation both in the room and/or through a one-way window. Additionally, you or your family ember may be recorded by video and/or audio while receiving services. If family members or friends are esent with you or your child during their therapy or evaluation session, any or all people could be recorde hey are within range of the recording device.			
These recordings and observations are used to teach. For example, therapy and evaluation techniques may be demonstrated to students, the student's interactions with clients may be evaluated, or a recording may be used as part of a teaching experience within the School of Communication Sciences and Disorders.  If a video and/or audio recording provides a good example of a particular communication disorder, interaction between client and therapist, or testing/therapy technique or approach, the Center may retain the recording and continue to use it for future educational purposes.
