Welcome to the University of Memphis Naval Reserve Officers Training Corps (NROTC) program. Congratulations on taking this significant step toward becoming a commissioned officer in the United States Navy or Marine Corps. The upcoming New Student Orientation (NSO), scheduled for August 17-23, 2025, is designed to introduce you to the standards, expectations, and camaraderie of our Company.

1) Purpose of NSO

NSO serves as an intensive introduction to the NROTC program, focusing on physical training, military customs, academic preparedness, and leadership development. Throughout the week, you will engage in various activities that require discipline, teamwork, and resilience.

2) Uniforms and Gear

While some incoming midshipmen may have attended training, such as NSI, and possess issued uniforms, others may not. To ensure uniformity and preparedness:

- a. PT Gear: All 4/C Midshipmen who have not attended NSI will be issued physical training (PT) gear upon arrival. Daily PT sessions are integral to NSO; therefore, appropriate attire is mandatory.
- b. Other Uniforms: No additional uniforms will be issued during NSO. Midshipmen with previously issued uniforms shall bring them.

- 1) PT Gear: All 4/C Midshipmen will be issued physical training gear upon arrival. No other uniforms will be provided during NSO. Participants with previously issued uniforms may bring them; however, they are not required for participation.
- 2) Labeling: Ensure all personal items are labeled with your name to prevent loss.
- 3) Footwear: It's recommended that all footwear be broken in prior to NSO to avoid discomfort or injury.
- 4) Prohibited Items: Do not bring weapons, tobacco products, alcohol, or any items that could be considered contraband
