An Act/Resolution to enable students to formally request a response from the Student Government Association.

WHEREAS, the Student Government Association is responsible for addressing the needs of students

WHEREAS, the students may request a response from their Student Government representatives regarding certain issues on campus

WHEREAS, there is no standardized method for students to submit said request

BE IT ENACTED BY THE 68th General Assembly OF THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION:

Section 1: The Student Government Association will create a separate section on their webpage where students can request a response from their representative.

- Section 2: The request will be sent to whomever in the organization can best address the issue.
- **Section 3:** The Student Government Association will have three business days to respond to the request.
- **Section 4:** This will replace informal means of communication (i.e. Twitter, verbal conversations) as the official means to request a reply from the Student Government Association.
- **Section 5:** This bill shall take effect by the start of the 2018-2019 academic school year, or as soon as the portion of the website is up and running.
- **Section 6:** This bill will cost the Student Government Association zero dollars in funding.
