ADDITIONAL ENDORSEMENTS ADDED BY COURSEWORK OR ASSESSMENT ONLY

Educators may apply for additional endorsements by coursework or content assessments only for each endorsement an educator is seeking to add if all the criteria below are met. To qualify for one of these options, educators must:

- 1. have completed an approved educator preparation program;
- 2. hold an active Tennessee educator license; and
- have completed additional endorsement coursework OR obtained qualifying scores on all state-required content assessments that are:
 - a. submitted to the Department directly by the assessment administrator (e.g., ETS or Pearson);
 - b. aligned with the requirements outlined in the State Board's <u>Professional Assessment Policy 5.105</u>

The following table lists endorsements that may be added by coursework or assessments only. Educators seeking an additional endorsement not listed in the table below must complete a qualifying endorsement program with applicable assessment(s) or possess an active out-of-state license with an aligned endorsement area.
