Welcome to the TESOL Program, which leads to a Master of Arts in Teaching (MAT) Degree and a Tennessee License to teach grades PreK-12. This degree sheet is a guide for selecting and sequencing courses required in the MAT program. - Teacher Education Program (TEP): MAT candidates must apply for admission to TEP before the end of the second semester and fulfill all TEP requirements. Candidates must have a 3.0 graduate GPA to be admitted to TEP and maintain a 3.0 GPA while in the graduate program.
- Licensure Exams: Candidates are required to pass Praxis II exams in order to be licensed to teach in
 Tennessee. For registration information, costs and more details go to www.ets.org, click on Praxis and use
 the dropdown menu to find the correct required exams.
- Job Embedded Practitioner (JEP) License: For information go to:

- edTPA: All candidates obtaining a MAT and TN Teaching Licensure must complete The Professional
 Seminar (ICL 7993). Each candidate must complete and pass a nationally scored teacher performance
 assessment, edTPA. You are only required to submit the edTPA portfolio if you are enrolled in ICL 7808.
 Job-embedded teacher candidates are not required to submit the edTPA.
