WEBSITE REDESIGN UNDERWAY

A Fresh Look is Coming to the Website The university is partnering with Modern Campus, the provider of Omni CMS, to redesign its website with the goal of enhancing user experience, simplifying content, and modernizing its digital presence. Marketing and Information Technology Services (ITS) are working together to implement new design templates, with a launch planned for October. Once the templates are in place, teams will migrate existing content and consult with site and page owners to review and approve the updates. As part of this redesign, the university will streamline its web presence by migrating only those pages with more than 10 views in the past year, reducing the total number of published pages by about 40%. This approach ensures the site remains current, relevant, and user-friendly, while legacy pages will still be accessible in Omni CMS for future use as needed.

Microsoft Bookings is an online appointment scheduling application that simplifies the process of setting up meetings and managing calendars. It allows departments, offices, and individual staff members to create customized booking pages where students and colleagues can easily schedule time based on availability. Bookings integrates seamlessly with Outlook calendars, ensuring that appointments are automatically synced and conflicts are avoided.

Key Features and Benefits

- Custom Booking Pages: Make pages for appointments with your own details and staff hours.
- Automatic Reminders: Sends emails to confirm and remind people about meetings.
- Calendar Sync: Works with Outlook, so appointments show up in your calendar.
